An overview of the NIH peer review process will be followed by an update on the current NIH Rigor and Transparency in Research policy that is now in effect for all (R-type) research and (K-type) training grant applications. Upcoming FY 2019 priorities, as established in the NIH-Wide Strategic Plan for Fiscal Years 2016-2020, will be presented with a highlight on research initiatives and funding opportunities of specific interest to quantitative biologists. Practical tips and resources for grant applicants will be presented. Finally, the workshop will end with an open Question and Answer session for the Q-Bio community.
